

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CLASSROOM, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF  
COMPREHENSIVE CURRICULUM AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SERVICES**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Agreement entered into an agreement with Classroom, Inc. for the purchase of comprehensive curriculum and professional development services for the Office of Student Support and Engagement (OSSE) at a cost not to exceed \$795,815.00. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis: the sole-source request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement Review Committee (NPRC), and approved by the Chief Executive Officer. The committee's decision is as follows:

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Services: Classroom, Inc. Area 9 Professional Development Services. Quantity: 40 teacher trainings. Flat

Rate: \$13,500.00, Total Cost Not to Exceed: \$13,500.00.
