RATIFY ENTERING INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT RELATING TO THE FY2008 AND FY2009 SECURE OUR SCHOOLS GRANT

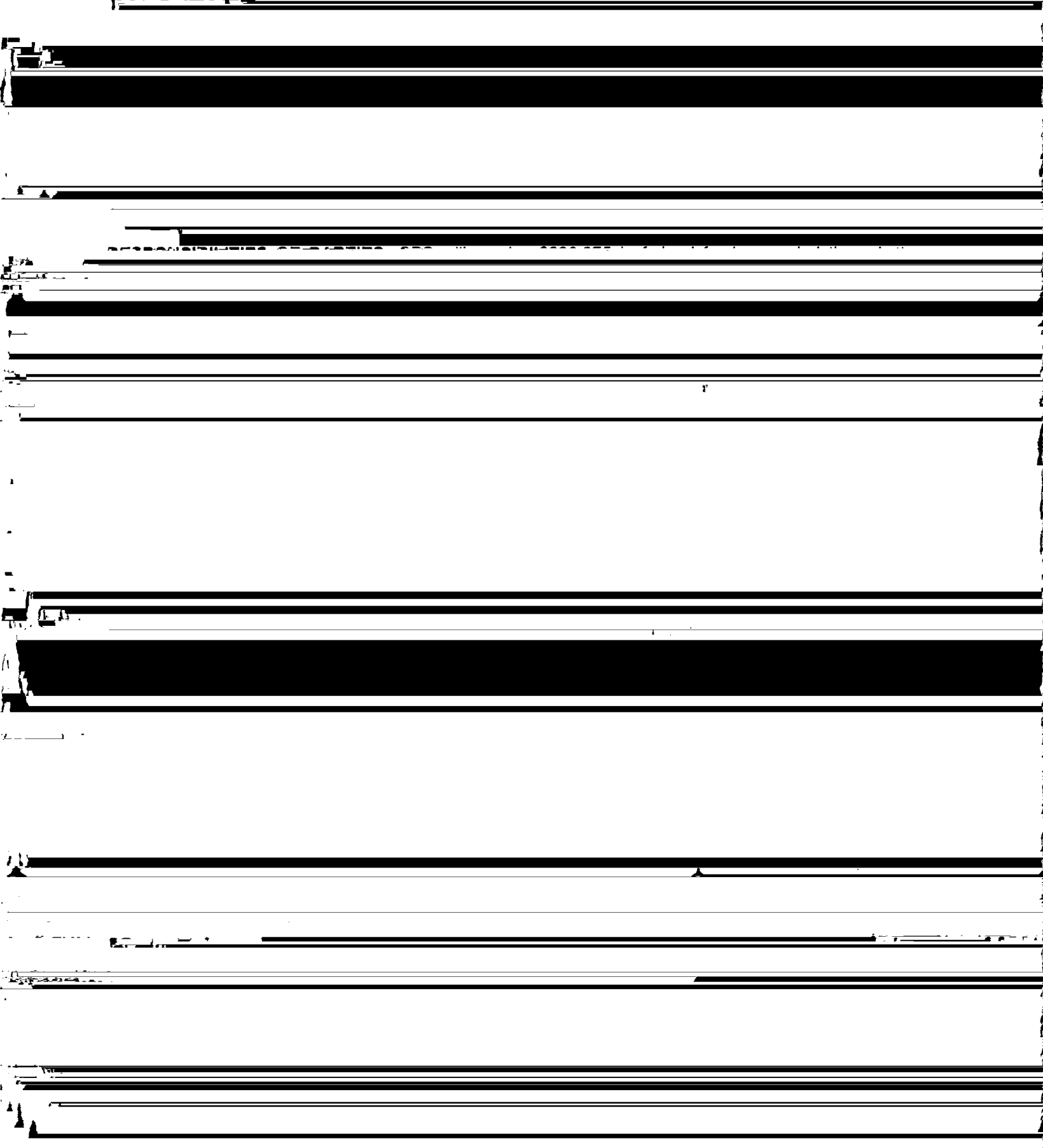
THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Ratify entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Chicago Police Department of the City of Chicago to implement a U.S. Department of Justice, Secure Our Schools Grant. The Chicago Public Schools collaborated with the Chicago Police Department to apply for a U.S. Department of Justice

Secure Our Schools grant. The grant was awarded to the Chicago Police Department to work in partnership to apply technology and de-escalation skills training to build relationships between police,

Grant based on a collaborative application with CPS. The award provides funding for x-ray machines and de-escalation training provided CPS and CPD provide local matching funds.

TERM: The term of this agreement shall commence on September 1, 2008 and shall end on August 31, 2011. ~~This agreement shall have no option to renew.~~



GENERAL CONDITIONS:
