

**APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL CENTER FOR TIME AND
LEARNING FOR LONGER SCHOOL DAY SUPPORT SERVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with National Center for Time and Learning ("Vendor") to provide support services to Chief Instruction Office at a total cost not to exceed \$248,000. Vendor was selected on a non-competitive basis: the sole-source request was presented to the Non-Competitive Procurement Review Committee and approved by Chief Purchasing Officer. A written agreement for this purchase is currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by Vendor and no payment shall be made to Vendor prior to execution of the written agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written agreement is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report.
