

**AUTHORIZE TUITION PAYMENTS TO DEPAUL UNIVERSITY FOR
MATHEMATICS AND SCIENCE COURSEWORK**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize tuition payments to DePaul University for mathematics and science coursework. DePaul is one of six universities participating in this program that were selected based on their previous involvement with mathematics and science programs in the Chicago Public Schools. The other participating universities, University of Chicago, University of Illinois – Chicago, Northwestern University, Illinois Institute of Technology and Loyola University, are authorized under separate Board Reports. 
