

APPROVE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CENTER FOR COMMUNITY ARTS

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Agrees entering into an agreement with Columbia College Chicago, Center for Community Arts

Vendor will identify and select veteran teaching artists for PD. The artists will be selected to meet the

needs of the schools and teachers participating in the Program

DELIVERABLES:

Vendor will deliver 40 hours of PD activities for the entire cohort of teachers including school-based PD, planning meetings, coaching, whole group PD, end of year curriculum sharing sessions, and Summer Institutes. Lead teachers (one arts specialist from each school) will receive an additional 12 hours of PD designed to build leadership capacity. Vendor will also create and facilitate an online learning community.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626 BOE) as amended

from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.
