

**AUTHORIZATION TO ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ILLINOIS STATE BOARD OF
EDUCATION SCHOOL MAINTENANCE PROGRAM**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the acceptance of grant funds for specific school maintenance projects. The Illinois State Board of Education is making up to \$10,000,000 available to Chicago Public Schools as part of its School Maintenance Grant Program. CPS will receive 20% of the amount raised by the State of Illinois. The dollar-for-dollar state matching grant program provides up to \$50,000 in matching funds for each project

related the maintenance or upkeep of buildings or structures for educational purposes. Chicago Public Schools is required to provide local matching funds in an amount equal to the grant. Information pertinent to the grant program is as follows:
