ADVISORY IMPLEMENTATION SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve exercising the option to renew the agreements with Umoja Student Development Corporation and Educators for Social Responsibility to provide advisory implementation services to Small Learning

OPTION PERIOD:

The term of each agreement is being extended for 9 months commencing August 1, 2012 and ending April 30, 2013.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:

There are no option periods remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendors will continue to provide advisory strategies to support personalized academic and postsecondary growth for students. Vendors will work with schools to create an effective advisory. Vendors will build supports with each school to create school wide advisory plans, build leadership capacity to sustain the work when the Vendors' contracts expire, and assist in creating full participation of all faculty in a robust

implementation of advisory.

DELIVERABLES:

Vendor will continue to provide the following deliverables; 1) Collaborative creation with schools to build advisory curriculum to meet the school's needs, 2) Design and deliver professional development, 3) Design and assist in implementation of a system of peer accountability among teachers, 4) Provide support for teachers struggling to implement advisory, and 5) Provide on-site evaluation of
