

APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE TEACHER REFERRAL AND SUPPORT AGREEMENT WITH TEACH FOR AMERICA

Agencies exercising the first option to renew the Teacher Referral and Support agreement with Teach for

America to refer and support up to 265 provisionally-certified first-year teacher-interns to Chicago Public Schools and support up to 200 second-year teacher-interns at a total cost for the entire period set to

Alternative Initial Teaching Certificate. TFA, working with partner Universities, will provide teacher-interns with all coursework and other necessary training in order to be provisionally certified by the Illinois State Board of Education and eligible for hire by Chicago Public Schools. Each teacher intern who is hired by

the Chicago Public Schools as a teacher of record will receive support services from Teach for America for a period of 2 years.

DELIVERABLES:

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted May 25, 2011 (11-0525-PO2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current

1999 year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to authorization in the subsequent fiscal year.
