Vendor will continue to process supply orders, deliver supplies directly to schools, remove bio-hazardous waste from schools, accept bio-hazardous waste mailed back from schools, and bill for supplies on a monthly basis.

OUTCOMES:

Vendor's products will result in a safe work and learning environment at all CDC facilities.

COMPENSATION:

Vendor shall be paid during this option period as follows: monthly as invoices are submitted and verified in accordance with the prices set forth in the written agreement; total not to exceed the sum of

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted June 23, 2004 (04-0623-PO4), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal year is deemed a contingent liability, subject to appropriation in the subsequent fiscal year budget(s).
