THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve entering into an agreement with Northwest Evaluation Association to provide a computer based



EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

The Board shall have the right to terminate this agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will provide assessments, reporting tools, professional development, consulting services, and implementation support for a computer-based adaptive assessment that will provide data that can be used to improve instruction and measure student learning growth. Additional services provided may include, but are not necessarily limited to, technical support, project management, and problem resolution, training, technology support and guidance from content and measurement experts.

USE OF SOFTWARE: The Board will use the software to administer multiple assessments each year in reading, mathematics, and science. Online student result reports will be immediately available upon the conclusion of testing. The system will provide web-based analytic and reporting tools that are easy to use and intuitive for users at all technical skill levels. Vendor will provide, and Board staff shall have access to, in person and online professional development and training opportunities to learn the concepts and

practices necessary to administer the assessment and apply its results to instruction.

DELIVERABLES:

Vendor will install the system at all participating schools and train all Board-identified users in the administration and use of the assessments.

OUTCOMES:

The Board will have the ability to administer multiple assessments per year in reading, mathematics and
