

**APPROVE EXERCISING ALL OPTIONS TO RENEW AGREEMENTS WITH SENTINEL TECHNOLOGIES FOR NETWORK MONITORING AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Approve exercising all options to renew the agreements with Sentinel Technologies (Vendor) to provide network monitoring and maintenance services for the Chicago Public Schools (CPS) wide area network.


