

APPROVE EXERCISING THE FIRST OPTION TO RENEW THE AGREEMENT WITH CENTER FOR COMMUNITY ARTS PARTNERSHIPS AT COLUMBIA COLLEGE FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Approve exercising the first option to renew the agreement with Columbia College Chicago Center for

Community Arts Partnerships (CCAP) to provide professional development services to district arts instructors and middle school instructors (in the Skoyway, Park Island, Dilson, Little Village, and

Austin North Lawndale Network) etc total cost not to exceed \$175,000.00. A written document

Educators (PDAE) grant, working collaboratively with the Board to provide professional development (PD)

As a result of efforts to 55% (40-50) teachers in seven (7) schools

In the Spring of 2011, the Office of Arts Education, with Areas formerly known as 10 and 17, conducted

the Arts Infrastructure Pilot Program. From that group of schools, the Department of Arts Education

selected seven (7) schools to receive treatment from this grant. PD consists of summer institutes
