

**RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO REGARDING THE  
SETTLEMENT OF CHICAGO TEACHERS UNION GRIEVANCE NUMBER 11-10-159,  
BROUGHT ON BEHALF OF ALL TEACHERS ASSIGNED TO CURTIS**

**SCHOOL OF EXCELLENCE FOR THE 2010-2011 SCHOOL YEAR**

**WHEREAS**, in June 2011, the Chicago Teachers Union ("CTU") filed Grievance No.11-10-159 (Grievance") on behalf of the teaching staff of the Curtis School of Excellence who were active during the 2010-2011 school year, alleging that they were directed to, and did, work additional unpaid time each school day without formally agreeing to do so through a waiver vote under Appendix C of the parties' 2007-2012 collective bargaining agreement; and

**WHEREAS** the Board and the CTU executed a settlement and general release agreement in

March 2013, in which the CTU agreed to withdraw the Grievance and grant the Board a general release in exchange for the aggregate amount of back pay stated below:
