APPROVE ENTERING INTO A SCHOOL MANAGEMENT CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH THE ACADEMY FOR URBAN SCHOOL LEADERSHIP TO PROVIDE SCHOOL TURNAROUND SERVICES AT LESLIE LEWIS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Board approve entering into a School Management Consulting Agreement ("Agreement") with

the Academy for Urban School Leadership ("AUSL") to provide school turnaround services at Leslie Lewis Elementary School ("Lewis") at a cost not to exceed \$300,000.00 with supplemental compensation on a per-pupil basis of \$420.00 for the operation of the elementary school. No services shall be provided by and no payment shall be made to AUSL prior to execution of the written Agreement. The authority

granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event the Agreement is not executed by the Board and

7. Assist the principal and the Local School Council to annually develop and implement a School Improvement Plan;
8. Provide a full-time professional field coach at Lewis who will provide ongoing school management consulting and professional development;
9. Provide enhanced fundraising opportunities to support implementation of school initiatives; and
10. Conduct a 2 week summer retreat for Lewis employees during the first year of the Agreement.






