

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:


Authorize tuition payments to DePaul University for mathematics coursework at a cost not to exceed \$283,960 for all participating universities. DePaul is one of three universities participating in this program that were selected based on their previous involvement with mathematics and science programs in the Chicago Public Schools. The other participating universities, University of Illinois at Chicago and

OUTCOMES: The Algebra I/II/III Course will be designed to meet the following outcomes:

algebra teachers in the middle grades. This creates increased opportunities for students to engage in a more rigorous mathematics program of study, such as enrollment in advanced mathematics courses as freshmen, which puts them on the pathway to enroll in advanced mathematics courses in high school and higher level postsecondary mathematics courses.
