

A DOPT A GRADE POINT AVERAGE POLICY

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS:

That the Board adopt a Grade Point Average (GPA) Policy.

PURPOSE: The District utilizes both a standard GPA calculation system and also a weighted GPA calculation system. This action will codify the methodology used to calculate a high school student's GPA.

POLICY TEXT:

Standard GPA Calculation. The GPA is a measure of a student's performance across all credit

Weighted GPA Calculation: For the weighted GPA, the calculation occurs in the same manner

as described in section 4 above, except that weighted grade values are assigned to each letter grade

based on the applicable course level designation as follows:

<i>Weighted Grade Values</i>				
<i>Letter Grade</i>	<i>Course Level</i>			
	<i>Significantly Modified</i>	<i>Regular</i>	<i>Honors</i>	<i>Advanced</i>

B. Effect on Graduation Honors. The effect of duplicate courses on any graduation honors or other honors offered by a high school is subject to principal discretion.
