**ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:**

The original Agreements (authorized by Board Report #09-1216-PR14) in the total aggregate amount of \$17,784,384.00 were for a term commencing October 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2013, with the Board having three options to renew for periods of one year each. The agreements were renewed (authorized by Board Report #10-0400-PR14) for a term commencing October 1, 2013 and ending June 30, 2014. The

original agreements were awarded on a competitive basis pursuant to Board Rule 7-2.

**OPTION PERIOD:**

The term of each agreement is being renewed for one year commencing July 1, 2014 and ending June 30, 2015.

**OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:**

There is one option period for one year remaining.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

Under the renewal of Contract 1 covering basic maintenance services eligible for the E-Rate discount,

- Maintain and/or collect and replace damaged telephone systems and components with new and/or refurbished equipment or software,

Complete system and component installations for ineligible sites, new construction sites and/or new

school or department initiatives,

- Re-programming of existing systems to accommodate new school or department initiatives, and
- Technical support for ineligible voice systems, handset placement.

**OUTCOMES:**

Mitel's services shall result in the Board having Mitel network systems and components maintained
