

**AUTHORIZE THE FIRST RENEWAL OF THE PRE-QUALIFICATION STATUS OF AND AGREEMENTS WITH 21 NOT-FOR-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS TO CONDUCT SERVICES FOR COMMUNITY SCHOOLS INITIATIVE (CSI)**

**THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:**

Authorize the first renewal of the pre-qualification status of and agreements with 21 not-for-profit organizations to implement services for the community schools initiative which serves students and families in the Chicago Public Schools ("CPS") at a cost not to exceed \$2,500,000 in the aggregate. Written renewal agreements are currently being negotiated. No services shall be provided by and no payment shall

be made to any not-for-profit organization prior to execution of their written renewal agreement. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each not-for-profit organization in the event such not for profit organization fails to execute their renewal agreement within 100 days of the date of this Board

programming. The opportunities provided must align to the Illinois Common Core Standards, the Continuous Improvement Work Plan ("CIWP"), and the Illinois Social and Emotional Learning Standards, where relevant. Students and their families shall also be able to choose from a variety of recreational, cultural and enrichment activities that provide opportunities to explore and develop skills, talents, and

hobbies.

**COMPENSATION:**

The sum of payments to all pre-qualified not-for-profit organizations during the renewal term shall not exceed \$2,500,000.00 in the aggregate. From time to time, the Chief Officer of College and Careers Success may reallocate funds among the not-for-profit organizations and change school assignments. Not-for-profit organizations shall be paid as invoices are submitted and verified by the school.

**USE OF POOL:**

The Community Schools Initiative, in the Office of College and Career Success, is authorized to receive

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted May 25, 2011 (11-0525-PO2), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Contingent Liability - The agreement shall contain the clause that any expenditure beyond the current fiscal


