**AUTHORIZE THE THIRD RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH VARIOUS VENDORS
FOR THE PURCHASE OF CHROMEBOOK COMPUTING DEVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the third renewal agreements with CDW Government, LLC and Sada Systems, Inc. to provide Chromebook computing devices for schools, network offices and departments at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. Written documents exercising this option are currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to any vendor during the option period prior to execution of their written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind as to each vendor in the event their written document is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:

There are two (2) option periods for one (1) year each remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendors will continue to provide chromebook computers with associated installation, asset tagging, auto enrollment, warranty, and user license services.

DELIVERABLES:

Vendors will continue to provide chromebook computing devices and associated services.

OUTCOMES:

These agreements will allow all schools, charter schools, and network offices, and central office departments to purchase chromebook computers and associated services including installation

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS
~~5/2A-42-1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain~~

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary
to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the
~~105 ILCS 5/2A-42-1, which states that the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education~~
