AUTHORIZE NEW AGREEMENTS WITH VENDORS TO PROVIDE SAFE HAVEN FOR AFTER

SCHOOL PROGRAMMING SERVICES

THE FOLLOWING OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING REGION:

TERM:

The term of each agreement shall commence on July 1, 2016 and shall end June 30, 2018. The agreements shall have (2) two options to renew for a period of (4) one year each.

EARLY TERMINATION RIGHT:

The Board shall have the right to terminate each agreement with 30 days written notice.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendors shall provide (or subcontract with third parties to provide) sites and services to elementary and/or high school students in at least twenty-five (25) different sites/locations during designated time periods throughout the school year in the targeted communities. Vendors shall include workshops on study skills.

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary

to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.
