THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING:


~~That the Chicago Board of Education does not renew the charter and charter school agreement ("Charter~~



Kwame Nkrumah Academy, Inc. shall wind down and cease operations of its charter school and return its charter to the Board effective as of July 1, 2019.


ORIGINAL AGREEMENT: The original Charter School Agreement (authorized by Board Report 11-0126-EX11) was for a term commencing July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2016 and authorized the operation of a charter school serving no more than 404 students in grades K through 8. The charter and Charter


