

**AUTHORIZE THE FIRST AND SECOND RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH IBOSS INC DBA IBOSS
CYBERSECURITY FOR WEB FILTERING SERVICES**

THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER REPORTS THE FOLLOWING DECISION:

Authorize the first and second renewal agreements with iBoss Inc dba iBoss Cybersecurity to provide web

filtering services to be utilized by all schools and departments at an estimated annual cost set forth in the Compensation Section of this report. A written document exercising these options is currently being negotiated. No payment shall be made to Vendor during the option period prior to execution of the written document. The authority granted herein shall automatically rescind in the event a written document is not executed within 90 days of the date of this Board Report. Information pertinent to this action is stated

OPTION PERIOD:

The term of this agreement is being renewed for two (2) years commencing April 1, 2019 and ending

March 31, 2021.

OPTION PERIODS REMAINING:

There are no option periods remaining.

SCOPE OF SERVICES:

Vendor will continue to provide web filtering services, equipment, applications and support services for the District via a hybrid cloud service.

DELIVERABLES:

Vendor will continue to provide web filtering services, equipment, applications and support services for the District via a hybrid cloud service.

OUTCOMES:

Vendor's services will result in CPS ensuring compliance with the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA), enabling CPS to remain eligible for E-Rate Category 2 funding.

COMPENSATION:

Estimated annual costs for the two (2) year term are set forth below:
