In 2012, the City and CPS identified the CLASS observation tool as the instrument to measure classroom

quality within all early childhood classrooms across the city of Chicago. Beginning SY18-19, both organizations will contract with National Louis University to conduct classroom observations utilizing the CLASS tool which was previously performed by independent consultants. All classroom observation results will be held within the myTeachstone database platform. myTeachstone is currently being used by the City
