ORIGINAL AGREEMENT:

The original Agreement authorized by Board Report 17-0524-PR6 in the amount of \$813,000 is for a term commencing July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2020, with the Board having two (2) options to renew for

Chicago Middle School Debate League (CMSDL) Judges: The CMSDL Program requires paid judges for
Tournament days. The CMSDL requires a minimum of 25 middle school judges per tournament day.

Tournament Meals: The CDC provides meals at select Tournaments in the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022
debate season, as determined by CPS. The events are at the discretion of the Office of Teaching and
Learning/ Department of Academic Competitions.

Tournament Awards: The CDC provides awards in debate competitions throughout the debate season.

Executive Management Support: The CDC provides overall executive management for both Middle
School and High School Debate for the current year for the Chicago Debate League, which is an leadership of

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

Inspector General - Each party to the agreement shall acknowledge that, in accordance with 105 ILCS 5/34-13.1, the Inspector General of the Chicago Board of Education has the authority to conduct certain

investigations and that the Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to conduct those investigations.

Conflicts - The agreement shall not be legally binding on the Board if entered into in violation of the provisions of 105 ILCS 5/34-21.3 which restricts the employment of, or the letting of contracts to, former Board members during the one year period following expiration or other termination of their terms of office.

Indebtedness - The Board's Indebtedness Policy adopted June 26, 1996 (96-0626-PO3), as amended from time to time, shall be incorporated into and made a part of the agreement.

Ethics - The Board's Ethics Code adopted March 25, 2014 (14-0505-PO3)
