RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES AND ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO THE
CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) AND MOVING FORWARD TOGETHER INITIATIVE FOR
FY22

WHEREAS, since early 2020, the United States, Illinois and Chicago have faced a pandemic that

has caused extraordinary sickness and loss of life, infecting over 225,000 Chicagoans and taking the lives

of more than 5,600 residents of the City;

WHEREAS, as Chicago residents continues to respond to the public health disaster caused by
Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), a novel severe acute respiratory illness that spreads rapidly
through respiratory transmissions, the burden on residents throughout the State has been unprecedented;

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago has received a grant from the State of Illinois for the purpose of

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby directs as follows:

1. The leadership of CPS shall collaborate with the IDPH and CDPH to review, update and implement emergency operations plans and plans for opening schools in accordance with City of Chicago and

CDPH guidance, including those for performing environmental cleaning, creating communications plans for the CPS community and providing critical support services, such as continuity of education (for example, web-based instruction and email) and student services (such as, meal and social and emotional services)

for students moving forward
