### Call for Quality Schools evaluation process and timeline

- The Call for Quality Schools is the process through which the District solicits proposals for new schools, regardless of type.
- CPS issued the CFQS on 6/29/12 and received proposals on 8/13/12. A public hearing to consider the proposals was held on 12/13/12 in board chambers.
- The CFQS requires applicants to submit thorough proposals that address areas such as educational program, operational plan, fiscal soundness, governance, and how they will meet the needs of all

- CPS has over 15 years of authorizing experience

- All best practices in authorizing are aligned toward approving only high quality school proposals.


# The CFQS evaluation is aligned with practices tied to high performance

**CFQS Criteria** 

**Practice of High-**

Provide teachers with formal or informal feedback	The educational evaluation plan includes <b>criteria for teacher evaluation</b> that clearly support the school's educational philosophy and professional culture, schedules and <b>processes for teacher observation and evaluation</b> . Data-driven instruction	The proposal clearly articulates how student data will be used to make curricular adjustments, improve instruction, and identify areas for professional development.	
High-dosage tutoring	The plan clearly articulates methods for identifying student needs upon enrollment, demonstrates a clear understanding of <b>expected remediation and accelerated learning needs</b> , and includes programs and services to ensure all students are challenged with the appropriate level of rigor.
