Changes from 2011-12



Changes to both Track R and Track E schools include:

10 additional days of student attendance for a total of 180 days

More five-day weeks from 20 or 22 full weeks to 29 full weeks

Conversion of report card pick-up days to attendance days

Students are dismissed 3 hours early

Report card pick-up occurs for 5.5 hours after students are dismissed

Repositioning PD and Teacher Institute days to better serve teachers

5 PD days at the beginning of the year to prep for the new year

1 TI day at the end of each quarter for data review and planning

Reducing holidays from ten to eight, changing Columbus and Pulaski Days from holidays to student attendance days

Changes to Track E schools include:

Reducing spring intercession from two to one week


